- **60m and 60m hurdles:** These will be the first events – starting with Senior Men.
- **200m, 300m/400m, 800m, 1500m:** (NB U15B, U15G, U17W run 300m not 400m).
- Dependent on entries, separate track races will be held for each County
- **High Jump, Long Jump and Pole Vault:** Normal rules apply
- **Triple Jump:** (Minimum Take Off Boards will be: SM 11m/13m, U20M 9m/11m, SW, U20W, U17M, U17W, U15G, U15B 7m/9m)
- **Shot:** Each competitor has four trials.

The Organising Committee reserves the right to alter the above when drawing up the timetable or on the day.

- Timetables will be sent via e-mail and posted on the County website once entries have closed.
