The following events for both men and women and all age groups will take place on either Saturday or Sunday:-

SATURDAY:

Track:-

Sprint Hurdles, 100m, 300m (U15 & U17W), 400m (U17M, U20 & Seniors), 1500m (All Age Groups)

Field:-

High Jump (All Age Groups)
Triple Jump (U15, U17, U20 and Seniors)
Shot Put (All Age Groups)
Discus (U15, U17, U20 and Seniors)

- All events will be in accordance with UKA Rules
- Ambulant disabled athletes are welcome to compete in all suitable events.
- High Jump, Long Jump and Pole Vault: Normal rules apply
- Triple Jump: (Minimum Take Off Boards will be: SM 11m/13m, U20M 9m/11m, SW, U20W, U17M, U17W, U15G, U15B 7m/9m)
- Shot, Javelin, Hammer, Discus, Long Jump & Triple Jump: Each competitor has three trials with the top eight having an additional 3 trials.
- Sprint Hurdles: 70mH (U13G), 75mH (U13B/U15G), 80mH (U15B/U17W), 100mH (U17M/U20W/SW), 110mH (U20M/SM)
- As U13s may only compete in one 800m or 1500m in a day these events may be run as time trials.

REGISTRATION:-

- Please note that you must register and collect numbers for each event one hour before the scheduled start time and late arrival may result in being unable to compete.
- The Organising Committee reserves the right to alter the above when drawing up the timetable or on the day.

ENTRIES:

- Entry Fee per event is £10 for Seniors and £8 for all other age groups.
- Closing date for entries is Midnight Sunday 30th April 2023
- Timetables will be sent via e-mail and posted on the County website once entries have closed but PLEASE NOTE THAT THE TIMETABLE FORMAT IS DIFFERENT TO PREVIOUS YEARS
- Entry will be via <u>www.opentrack.run</u>
- Athletes are eligible to compete in these Championships by birth or 9 months continuous residence or have competed for the County.
- Please note:- England Athletics rules stipulate ATHLETES MAY COMPETE IN THE CHAMPIONSHIPS OF ONLY ONE COUNTY IN THE COMPETITIVE YEAR (OCTOBER 2022 TO SEPTEMBER 2023).
- Club/Representative vests must be worn- UKA RULE T5 (143) S1 (4)
- Athletes in all Age Groups must have an up to date registration with their National Association as per UKA rule 20.

PLEASE NOTE THAT LATE ENTRIES WILL <u>NOT</u> BE ACCEPTED

AGE GROUP INFORMATION:

- U13s, U15s & U17s may only compete in up to three events on any day
- U20s may only compete in up to five events on any day
- Under 15, Under 17 and Senior Age Groups are as at Midnight 31/08/23
- Under 20 Age Group are Over 17 on 31/08/23 but Under 20 on 31/12/23
