Disability Field Events are for classified Ambulant Athletes Only. Ambulant Track Athletes may compete in suitable Track Events.

- 60m and 60m hurdles: These will be the first events of the day.
- 200m, 300m/400m, 800m, 1500m: (NB U15B, U15G, U17W run 300m not 400m).
- Walks can enter either the 2km Walk or the 3km Walk as the two races will start together
- Dependent on the number of entries, separate track races will be held for each County
- High Jump, Long Jump and Pole Vault: Normal rules apply
- Triple Jump: (Minimum Take Off Boards will be: SM 11m/13m, U20M 9m/11m, SW, U20W, U17M, U17W, U15G, U15B 7m/9m)
- Shot, Long Jump & Triple Jump: Each competitor has four trials.

The detailed timetable will be completed after entries close and we know how many competitors are entered for each event. Please note that the allocation of events on Saturday or Sunday is provisional but we do not expect to have to make any changes, it has remained the same for the past few seasons. However if any changes are necessary we will refund entry fees when requested.

• LEE VALLEY TRACK ALLOWS ONLY "CHRISTMAS TREE" or "RT" (FLAT TIP) SPIKES. THESE SHOULD BE AVAILABLE FOR SALE ON THE DAY BUT PLEASE BRING YOUR OWN IF YOU HAVE THEM. At Lee Valley Athletics Centre the following spikes are accepted for use on the indoor track:

Omnilite Ceramic Pyramid or Christmas Tree 5mm or 7mm, Steel Christmas Tree 6mm, Steel RT Compression 6mm

Registration - Please note that you must register and collect numbers for each event one hour before the scheduled start time and late arrival may result in being unable to compete. Please remember to keep your number from day 1 if you are also competing on day 2.

The Organising Committee reserves the right to alter the above when drawing up the timetable or on the day.

THIS IS A CHAMPIONSHIP EVENT NOT AN OPEN MEETING, ONLY ENTER IF YOU ARE MIDDLESEX ELIGIBLE; resident in the Middlesex County area, born in the Middlesex County area or continually competed in Middlesex County events or for Middlesex County. Classified ambulant athletes who are not Middlesex eligible are welcome to enter the disability field events as guests.

Club/Representative vests must be worn- UKA RULE T5 (143) S1 (4)

THE EVENT IS HELD WITH TWO OTHER COUNTY CHAMPIONSHIPS; KENT AND HERTS WHO HAVE SEPARATE ONLINE ENTRIES.

AGE GROUP INFORMATION:

U13s are not allowed to enter
U15s & U17s may only compete in up to three events on any day
U20s may only compete in up to five events on any day
Under 15, Under 17 and Senior Age Groups are as at Midnight 31/08/25 (same as outdoor 2025 summer season)
Under 20 Age Group are Over 17 on 31/08/25 but Under 20 on 31/12/25
